Panel Topics

This year's conference is seeking panel discussions on educational trends in Data Analytics and Cyber Security, challenges in Online Learning, and issues related to implementing innovation in Pedagogy and IS Curriculum. However, we welcome strong proposals in any area related to Information Systems Education. The conference will feature four to six panel discussions.

Panel Submission Guidelines

- Panel discussion proposals should be submitted no later than July 1, 2015 via the submission system at http://csbapp.uncw.edu/edSig/
- A panel should consist of at least two, and not more than five panelists with at most two
 panelists from the same institution / affiliation.
- Each panel also must include a moderator (who is NOT a discussant) to help facilitate interaction.
- Panel proposals should include:
 - A brief (< 250 words) description of the topic(s) the panelists will present.
 - Details (name, title, affiliation) of the panelists and moderator include a very brief description of each panelist's expertise / background on the proposed topic.
 - The desired time which must be either 25 or 55 minutes in length.
- Presentation materials should be prepared for publication by September 1, 2015.
- All panelists and the moderator must be registered for the conference.
