Welcome to **ISECON 2007** in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. There is so much to see that you will only have time for a fraction of it. You have choices! These pages include the abstracts for nearly every presentation that is planned, so you can spend your time as carefully as you would like.

Are you looking for your favorite people or schools? Two **indexes** at the end of this document will help you find what you want.

A **DTRS** (Day/Time/Room/Seq) code identifies each presentation. For Day, 1=Thu, 2=Fri, 3=Sat, and 4=Sun. For Time, 1=EarlyAM and 7=LatePM. The third digit identifies the room, and the fourth digit specifies the order within that room. Titles are truncated to 125 characters. Abstracts are truncated to 1500 characters.

Most papers are grouped by similarity of topic, so you may be able to put down roots and watch several presentations in a row. But we all have many interests, and you may wish to change rooms between presentations, or chat with a colleague in the foyer.
